## **MESSAGE** TO SHAREHOLDERS

Happy New Year – 2024!

We are pleased to report we ended our 2023 fiscal year (Nov 2022 – Oct 2023) with \$7.6 million in patronage. While we are still reviewing and auditing patronage claims, we expect the rebate will be about \$55-60/ton when complete, which is in line with our objectives set at the beginning of the year.

Ammonia prices steadily declined from October 2022 through July 2023 (-75%!), but then rebounded in the back half of 2023. As a result, we've recently had to increase our prices since the summer lows.

We have completed the 20-year inspection and related maintenance on one of two 20,000 ton ammonia storage tanks. This is a big, expensive, time-consuming effort, which we will repeat this year on the 2nd storage tank following the busy spring season.

You may have seen that the J.R. Simplot Company has announced the closing of their Lathrop fertilizer plant later this year. This will have a significant impact on CALAMCO, as Lathrop historically purchases 20-25,000 tons of ammonia per year. Losing this volume will increase the dollar per ton rate on our fixed cost areas by approximately \$20 per ton.

We are again targeting a \$55 per ton patronage in Fiscal Year 2024. We hope ammonia prices have found their near term peak as December pricing was unchanged versus November. ■


The meeting portion of our program will begin following dinner at approximately 8:00 pm, and we will conclude with a variety of door prizes.

# This past year, CALAMCO hired eight new employees at the Stockton terminal. The new employees were hired as drivers for our growing trucking fleet, which currently totals fifteen trucks and drivers. As openings in the terminal become available, drivers are able to move into open operator positions.

CALAMCO has been growing our trucking operation to offset the need to hire third-party carriers during our peak season demand. During the off-season, we have dedicated six drivers and three trucks to assist with hauling propane for a local propane distributor. In addition, a few of our drivers are dedicated to our long-haul deliveries.

# AMMONIA STORAGE TANK INSPECTION

CALAMCO has recently completed a mandatory 20-year inspection of storage tank D1 and its associated piping. This was a major effort that required careful coordination between multiple subcontractors, inspectors, and our knowledgeable operations and maintenance personnel. The storage tank, piping, and valves were verified to be in excellent condition. This year following our Spring season, our second storage tank will undergo the same process. CALAMCO maintains a comprehensive mechanical integrity program to ensure the safe continued operation of all assets.

## **SAFETY TIPS FOR WINTER DRIVING**

Driving in winter means adapting the way you drive to inclement weather. Snow, rain, sleet, and ice can lead to hazardous road conditions. For winter vehicle preparedness and driving, AAA recommends the following:

## WINTER VEHICLE PREPAREDNESS:

- Test your battery; battery power drops as the temperature drops
- Install winter tires with a deeper, more flexible tread
- Check the tire pressure; tire pressure drops as the temperature drops
- Check your wiper blades and replace if needed
- Keep your gas tank at least half full to avoid freezing in the gas line

### WINTER DRIVING:

- Avoid using cruise control in wintry conditions
- Accelerate and decelerate slowly
- Increase following distance to 8 to 10 seconds

- If possible, don't stop when going uphill
- If visibility is severely limited, pull off the road to a safe place

Be sure to have Regional Area Emergency Numbers saved for the area you are traveling to and keep your emergency roadside vehicle kit fully stocked. ■
